

1. Website Terms and Conditions of Use

1.1. These Terms pertain to the access and use of the information, services and functions provided on the Website.

1.2. In terms of section 11 of the ECT Act and the common law, these Terms are valid, binding and enforceable against all persons that access this Website, its web pages or any part thereof.

1.3. Agile Wagile permits the use of this Website subject to the Terms. By using this Website, the User shall be deemed to have accepted all the Terms on an unconditional basis. If the User does not agree to be bound by these Terms, the User must leave the Website without delay, as further use will automatically bind the User to these Terms.

7. Agile Wagile Privacy and Cookie Policy

7.1. This clause 9 provides details regarding Agile Wagile's privacy and cookie policy (the "Privacy Policy"), which forms part of these Terms.

7.2. This Privacy Policy sets out how Agile Wagile uses and protects any Personal Information given to it electronically by the User and the Users rights in relation to such Personal Information in accordance with POPI. By volunteering personal information to Agile Wagile on any part of the Agile Wagile Website or Social Media Pages or any other manner, the User consents to the use and transfer of such information on the provisions as set out herein. Agile Wagile shall, however, take all reasonable measures to ensure that the User's Personal Information remains protected and confidential and shall store the User's Personal Information on the terms required by applicable legislation.

7.3. Personal Information detailed above is collected either electronically by using cookies or is provided voluntarily by the User, such as the User's name, age, identity number and contact information. Such Personal Information that has been shared on the respective social media application, will be done so entirely at one's own risk, and in accordance with the respective social media applications privacy policy. Agile Wagile will not be held responsible for any other user's use, misuse, or misappropriation of any Personal Information or other information that a User may contribute to any Social Media application.

7.5. By volunteering personal information on the Website or Social Media pages, the User consent's to receiving marketing and promotional material from Agile Wagile and its subsidiaries. 7.7. The User shall have a right to request the details of their Personal Information held by Agile Wagile in terms of POPI. 7.8. By providing information through this Website or any Social Media pages, the User hereby consents to the disclosures described above.

7.9. How Agile Wagile collects Personal Information?

7.9.1. The User may provide Personal Information to Agile Wagile when communicating with Agile Wagile and/or utilising its functions and/or services.

7.9.2. Agile Wagile may collect Personal Information from a variety of sources, including, but not limited to directly from the User, and/or Personal Information about the User obtained from other sources, including commercially available sources, such as public databases

(where permitted by law). Where possible, the User will be informed about what information is required and what information is voluntary.

7.9.3. We may collect the following information including, but not limited to, the User's:

7.9.3.1. data concerning the User as an individual, including the User's full name, telephone numbers, email addresses, location, physical and postal address, and any other information provided which concerns the User as an individual;

7.9.3.2. business related information (such as name, address, telephone numbers, payment arrangements, financial information, etc.), the User's relationship with that business or organisation (such as owner, partner, director, shareholder, employee, or agent), and the User's contact details within that business (such as work address, work telephone and mobile numbers, work fax number, and work e-mail address);

7.9.3.3. information collected or generated out of any surveys Agile Wagile conducts;

7.9.3.4. correspondence, communications and messages, including between the User and Agile Wagile, and between Agile Wagile and third parties; and

7.9.3.5. Website usage information.

7.9.4. In the event of a User providing Personal Information to Agile Wagile on behalf of an organisation, the User warrants that it is an authorised representative of such organisation and is authorised to provide the Personal Information on behalf of the relevant organisation.

7.9.5. Personal Information will only be collected for lawful purposes in accordance with the requirements contemplated in POPI and the necessary steps to inform the User of the purpose(s) for which the personal information is collected will be taken.

7.10. How Agile Wagile uses the User's Personal Information?

7.10.1. Agile Wagile may use the User's Personal Information to validate the User as a customer, for market segmentation, remarketing to the User, marketing upcoming events and services on behalf of selected third parties and recruiting new business. The User is entitled to request that Agile Wagile desists from using the User's Personal Information for the purposes of marketing, and Agile Wagile will provide the User with the necessary functionality for the User to do so with ease, each time Agile Wagile markets to the User.

7.10.2. Agile Wagile utilises "first party cookies" (cookies originating from Agile Wagile) amongst other reasons, to simply track the User's visits between sessions and deliver a more personalised experience. 7.10.4. 7.11. How long does Agile Wagile keep the User's information for? The time periods for which Agile Wagile keeps the User's Personal Information may vary according to the use or purpose attached to the Personal Information. Unless there is a specific legal requirement requiring Agile Wagile to keep the User's Personal Information, Agile Wagile will not keep it for longer than is deemed necessary by Agile Wagile (in accordance with their data retention policy which sets out the data retention periods) for the purpose for which the Personal Information was collected or for which it is to be processed.

7.12. Disclosing the User's Personal Information to third parties

7.12.1. Agile Wagile may provide information to third parties but these statistics will not include any information that could identify the User. Agile Wagile will only disclose, distribute or transfer the User's Personal Information to third parties on the following basis:

7.12.1.1. where Agile Wagile has the User's permission;

7.12.1.2. where Agile Wagile is required to do so by law; or

7.12.1.3. where such transfer would otherwise comply with law.

7.12.2. In the event that Agile Wagile provides information to third parties, Agile Wagile will use its best efforts to ensure that those third parties will only use that data exclusively for the purposes of discharging their service obligations. Moreover, Agile Wagile will use its best efforts to ensure that these third parties treat the data as confidential as well as ensuring that requirements for the safeguarding of said information are stipulated in contractual agreements with the third party (if applicable).

7.12.3. Subject to clause

7.9.1, the User consents to Agile Wagile and/or any of its partners or subsidiaries using, reviewing, collecting, processing and distributing the Personal Information provided to Agile Wagile for any purposes associated with Agile Wagile's objectives.

7.13. Sharing the User's Personal Information cross border.

7.13.1 Agile Wagile will only transfer a User's personal information to third parties in another country in any one or more of the following circumstances:

7.13.1.1 The User's personal information will be adequately protected under the other country's laws, or an agreement with the third-party recipient; or

7.13.1.2 Where the transfer is necessary to enter, or perform, under a contract with the User, or a contract with a third party that is in the data subject's interest; or

7.13.1.3 Where the User has consented to the transfer; or

7.13.1.4 Where it is not reasonably practical to obtain consent, and the country to which the information is transferred does not have applicable laws, Agile Wagile will ensure that said third party would at the least, apply security safeguards that Agile Wagile would itself apply to secure the User's personal information.

7.14. When and where does Agile Wagile use cookies? Agile Wagile allocates cookies amongst other times, from the time that the User lands on the Website, during the registration process for Agile Wagile's services, in obtaining Agile Wagile's services, to make an inquiry and to engage in Agile Wagile's services. 7.18. How can the User correct or delete personal information? The User can request, where allowed by law, the correction, updating or deletion of the Personal Information held. 7.19. How can the User object to the processing of their information? 8. Confidentiality

8.1. 9. Breach or Cancellation

9.1. Agile Wagile is entitled, without notice, in addition to any other remedy available to it at law or under these Terms, including obtaining an interdict, to limit or deny such User use of the Website and services, or to claim specific performance of any obligation whether or not the due date for performance has arrived, in either event without prejudice to Agile Wagile's right to claim damages, should any User:

9.1.1. breach any of these Terms;

9.1.2. in the sole discretion of Agile Wagile, use the Website in an unauthorised manner; or

9.1.3. infringe any statute, regulation, ordinance or law.

9.2. Breach of these Terms entitles Agile Wagile to take legal action without prior notice to the User and the User agrees to reimburse the costs associated with such legal action to Agile Wagile on an attorney and own client scale.

10. 11. Compliance with laws The User shall comply with all applicable laws, statues, ordinances and regulations pertaining to the use of and access to this Website.

12. Time and Place of Contracting

12.1. The User and Agile Wagile agree that the User shall be bound to these Terms and such agreement is concluded in Johannesburg (South Africa) at the time the User enters the Website for the first time.

12.2. The information and services advertised on the Website do not constitute an offer but merely an invitation to do business.

13. Notices and Electronic Communications

14.8. Words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing the masculine gender shall include females and words importing persons shall include partnerships and corporate and unincorporated entities.

14.9. These Terms set forth the entire understanding and agreement between Agile Wagile and the User with respect to the subject matter hereof.

14.10. These terms and conditions constitute the sole record of the agreement between Agile Wagile shall be bound by any express tacit nor implied representation, warranty, promise or the like not recorded herein. These terms and conditions supersede and replace all prior commitments, undertakings or representations, whether written or oral, between the User and Agile Wagile in respect of the subject matter hereof.
